



## 2025 FALL BOW® Nova Scotia Bursary

### Bursary Application Deadline

**July 19, 2025**

The 2025 Becoming an Outdoors Woman® Fall Workshop registration cost is \$350.00. There are a limited number of bursaries available for partial payment of \$220.00 for those meeting the criteria. The remainder of the registration fee (\$130.00) is the responsibility of the applicant and must be paid on registration. Bursary applications must be received by midnight **July 19, 2025**. Successful bursary recipients will receive a **PROMO** code to use with the online registration opening **August 2, 2025**. Classes often fill within hours, so log in early!

Bursaries are offered to residents of Nova Scotia who are first-time participants, and either full-time students, single parents or from low-income households (see the application form). Those who have previously received a bursary/scholarship funding are not eligible. **Receiving a bursary does not give you priority in classes. You should still register as soon as registration is open August 2, 2025 at 9:00 am to get your first-choice classes.**
